


Fall Semester Student Enrollment







Fall Credit Hour Growth




Enrollment Residency




Enrollment by Educational Site

Enrollment by Type




Enrollment by Program of Study




Higher Education Appropriations


Comparison of Higher Education Appropriations




State Appropriations per FTE


